***Company to Provide Web-based Dashboard Solution for Washington Headquarters  
Services***

**Vienna, Virginia – January 12, 2009** – AnviCom, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Command Information, the premier provider of next generation network services, today announced it has been awarded a task order by the Defense Information Technology Contracting Organization (DITCO) to provide support to the Washington Headquarters Services (WHS) Information Technology Management Directorate (ITMD). This contract was awarded via DITCO’s ENCORE II contract vehicle. Under the terms of the task order, AnviCom will implement a Web-based performance dashboard solution.

ENCORE II – an indefinite delivery, indefinite quantity (IDIQ) contract – is open to all Military Agencies, DoD, and other agencies of the Federal government and is for a base period of five years with five one-year options and has a ceiling value of \$12.225 billion. AnviCom is one of 12 prime contractors under the Small Business Set-Aside portion of the contract.

“ENCORE II provides the government with a more efficient and economical mechanism to purchase IT products and services,” said Proper. “This is our initial task order from this contract vehicle and we are looking forward to initiating work.”
